## MISSION ACTION PLAN

**Our purpose** as people and ministers of this parish is to sustain a pattern of worship and teaching that meets the pastoral needs of our situation, making the best use we can of our buildings, opening them for activities that serve the purpose of community-building, and the proclamation of the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

**Our aim** is to increase the number of regular active participants in the church's worship and ministry.

In the light of changing circumstances we identify the following **key areas** requiring concerted action from church members a) before the AGM of 2004; b) during 2004.

- To recruit and appoint a new parish treasurer, who is willing to work at computerising accounts and implementing the new legally required audit procedures by the 2004 AGM.
- To ensure that the parish quota is paid, and an overall balanced budget is maintained.
- To create and bring into operation a parish office, staffed by volunteers, by the 2004 AGM.
- To increase the number of actively contributing worshippers in each congregation by at least five people by the end of 2004.
- To recruit new volunteer teams to run the Parish Tea-Room and keep it open Tuesday to Saturday each week, by the end of 2004.
- To ensure that all church officers, PCC and Church Committee members undertake at least one new learning activity in 2004 which will help refresh and strengthen their prayer life and understanding of the bible.
- To ensure that every organisation within our churches, before the AGM 2004 reports are written, reviews its life and purpose, and formulates exactly what its contribution to the work of mission and ministry in the parish consists of.
